### Week 1: You and your house

## Week 2 As for me and my house

## Apply the blood

**Exodus 12: 7 Then they are to take some of the blood and put it on the sides and tops of the doorframes of the houses where they eat the lambs.**

- (1) The Blood was a proclamation
- (2) The Blood brought protection
- (3) The Blood brought prosperity

**36The Lord had made the Egyptians favorably disposed toward the people, and they gave them what they asked for; so they plundered the Egyptians.**

**Material wealth is highly valued in the Torah the Hebrews seek it and God promises to bless them**

## Week 3 Eat The Meat

**Exodus 12: 8That same night they are to eat the meat roasted over the fire, along with bitter herbs, and bread made without yeast. 9Do not eat the meat raw or boiled in water, but roast it over a fire—with the head, legs and internal organs. 10Do not leave any of it till morning; if some is left till morning, you must burn it. 11This is how you are to eat it: with your cloak tucked into your belt, your sandals on your feet and your staff in your hand. Eat it in haste; it is the Lord's Passover**

## (1) The Lamb was roasted

This speaks of God's Judgment on Jesus for our sin

The **whole** lamb Roasted over fire.

FIRE = Judgement

Isaiah 53: New Living **3**He was despised and rejected— a man of sorrows, acquainted with deepest grief. We turned our backs on him and looked the other way. He was despised, and we did not care. **4**Yet it was our weaknesses he carried; it was our sorrows<sup>a</sup> that weighed him down. And we thought his troubles were a punishment from God, a punishment for his own sins! **5**But he was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. He was beaten so we could be whole. He was whipped so we could be healed. **6**All of us, like sheep, have strayed away. We have left God's paths to follow our own. Yet the Lord laid on him the sins of us all. **7**He was oppressed and treated harshly, yet he never said a word. He was led like a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth.

I cannot access the blessing of God if I feel that I am not worthy to receive it

Eat The Meat

God has judged you

You were found guilty

**Romans 3: 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. 25God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement,<sup>i</sup> through the shedding of his blood—to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in his forbearance he had left the sins committed beforehand unpunished— 26he did it to demonstrate his righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the one who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.**

Verse 26 Amplified ***This was to demonstrate His righteousness [which demands punishment for sin], because in His forbearance [His deliberate restraint] He passed over the sins previously committed [before Jesus' crucifixion].***

**God punished Jesus for all your sins**

**You cannot be punished by God otherwise God would be unjust.**

**To pay twice is fraud**

**Exodus 12:10 Do not leave any of it till morning; if some is left till morning, you must burn it.**

**Not in His eyes so not in yours either**

**I want to live like He sees me **FREE FROM SIN****

**Live in the revelation of Not Guilty**

**Eat The Meat**

**Romans 8: 1**Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, **2**because through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you<sup>a</sup> free from the law of sin and death.

**3**For what the law was powerless to do because it was weakened by the flesh,<sup>b</sup> God did by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh to be a sin offering.<sup>c</sup> And so he condemned sin in the flesh, **4**in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

**Romans 5: 6** You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. **7**Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. **8**But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**9**Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!

**10**For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!

**Satan's plan is to set the trap of sin**

**You fall into the trap of sin**

**satan then keeps you in guilt which drives you back into sin**

**Eat the meat enjoy the meal.**

**It's a celebration meal**

**Hebrews 9: 14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death,<sup>c</sup> so that we may serve the living God!**

**If you live with a clean conscience you can live in the blessing of God.**

**Faith in the finished work of the cross releases faith for the blessing of God**

**Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.**

**Exodus 14: 12 Didn't we say to you in Egypt, 'Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians'? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!"**

**13Moses answered the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. 14The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still."**
