I Need A Word

Jesus had just fed the 5000

Matthew 14: 22 And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away. 23And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone. 24But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary, **25**And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. 26And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. 27But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. 28And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. 29And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

God's word always brings faith

(A) Give me a Rhema = Revealed Word

Instant and present word spoken from God

Romans 10: <u>15</u> And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! <u>16</u>But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? <u>17</u>So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

word = Transliteration: rhéma Definition: a word, by implication a matter Usage: a thing spoken, a word or saying of any kind, as command, report, promise,

Preaching Brings Faith

Don't allow your need for a word to be fear based

What if I get it wrong?

Will I fail?

Will I be forsaken?



A WORD

Luke 5:1And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret, 2And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing their nets. 3And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship. 4Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught. 5And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net. 6And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake. 7And they beckoned unto their partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. Preaching speaks Rhema

Isaiah 61: <u>1</u> The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

I NEED

The Prophetic speaks Rhema

Hebrews 1:1 In the past God spoke to our ancestor through the prophets at many times and in various ways,

The Holy Spirit speaks Rhema

1 Kings 19:<u>12</u> After the earthquake a fire, *but* the LORD *was* not in the fire; and after the fire a sound of a gentle blowing. <u>13</u>When Elijah heard *it*, he wrapped his face in his mantle and went out and stood in the entrance of the cave. And behold, a voice *came* to him and said, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"

Urim and Thummim

In The Old Testament there was no experience of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit.

If there was a decision to be made and there was no prophet to inquire of the priest used the Urim and Thummim. Thought to be two stones. One with yes the other no written on them.

Some scholars believe the stones lit up the answer. Others believed the priest drew one out of a small bag and whichever one came out was the answer. Some believe they were made by God.

Exodus 28: <u>30</u> Also put the Urim and the Thummim in the breastpiece, so they may be over Aaron's heart whenever he enters the presence of the Lord. Thus Aaron will always bear the means of making decisions for the Israelites over his heart before the Lord.

(B) Give me a Logos = Written word or permanent word

Jesus is the permanent word of God. His plan has been constant throughout eternity

I NEED A WORD

John 1: <u>1</u> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <u>2</u>He was with God in the beginning. <u>3</u>Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. <u>4</u>In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

The Bible is The Person of Jesus in Words.

In Every Story, in every book it's Jesus.

His Nature and Character are seen in its pages.

God uses His logos to speak His Rhema

When we read the Logos in The Holy Spirit (Asking the Holy Spirit to make it alive in us) it can becomes our Rhema!

Exodus 14: Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you today:

A promise from the scriptures = A word in your spirit

2 Corinthians 1:<u>18</u> But as surely as God is faithful, our message to you is not "Yes" and "No." <u>19</u>For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us by me and Silas c and Timothy—was not "Yes" and "No," but in him it has always been "Yes." <u>20</u>For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. <u>21</u>Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, <u>22</u>set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

A Healing Logos becomes a healing Rhema

A Delivering Logos becomes a delivering Rhema

A Provision Logos becomes a provision Rhema

Yes and AMEN In Christ

Jesus is the Word (Logos), Jesus is the promise (Rhema) Jesus is the fulfilment

Isaiah 55: <u>11</u>so is my word that goes out from my mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. <u>12</u>You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands. <u>13</u>Instead of the thornbush will grow the juniper, and instead of briers the

myrtle will grow. This will be for the Lord's renown, for an everlasting sign, that will endure forever."

When God's Eternal Logos goes out of His mouth it becomes a present day Rhema

so is my word = Dabar is the Hebrew word for Logos

So is my word (LOGOS = JESUS)

It will not return to me empty (That's a Promise)

but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. (That's fulfilment, that's salvation)

The Two anchors of His Word

- (A) Give me a Rhema = Revealed Word
- (B) Give me a Logos = Written word or permanent word

GIVE ME JESUS

The Word when you are feeling Discouraged

Therefore the redeemed of the Lord shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away. Isaiah 51:11
